CRC Public Hearing in Fort Lauderdale at NSU Rick Case Arena

FORT LAUDERDALE, Fla. – The Constitution Revision Commission (CRC) invites all interested Floridians to participate in a public hearing being held today at Nova Southeastern University’s Rick Case Arena from 1:00-7:00 PM. This will be the first public hearing held on the CRC’s 2018 “Road to the Ballot” public hearing tour.

The goal of public hearings is to give Floridians an opportunity to provide feedback on the [37 proposals under active consideration by the CRC](#). Public hearings are free events open to all Floridians who would like to attend. No tickets or RSVPs are required. Free public parking will be provided.

Once every 20 years, Florida's Constitution provides for the creation of a 37-member revision commission for the purpose of reviewing Florida's Constitution and proposing changes for voter consideration. The Constitution Revision Commission (CRC) meets for approximately one year, traveling the State of Florida, identifying issues, performing research and possibly recommending changes to the Constitution.
